



Affordable housing, building codes, growth management, impact fees, and onsite and springshed protection top the list of issues that make up FHBA's 2008 legislative priorities.

Florida Home Builders Association members defined this list of issues as their 2008 Legislative Session priorities last week during the annual pre-session Governmental Affairs Committee meeting held in Orlando. The priority list was established following a two-tiered survey process.

FHBA's 2008 legislative priorities will soon be provided to lawmakers. During the 2008 Legislative Session, FHBA will monitor how lawmakers vote on the Association's priorities. Then, following the end of session, FHBA will produce a "Legislative Scorecard" grading lawmakers on their performance as it pertains to FHBA's priority issues.
