

# Salvation Army's Sallie House

TBBA's Sales and Marketing Council (SMC) has adopted a charity for 2008 – Salvation Army's Sallie House. The Sallie House is an emergency shelter for children who have been removed from their home due to abuse, neglect or abandonment. Due to the sensitivity and nature of these children's circumstances, they are often removed immediately without any opportunity to retrieve their personal belongings.



Over the last 17 years, Sallie House has provided shelter to more than 1,600 children from infant to eleven years of age. These children remain at this shelter until they can be placed in a safe environment with a family member, a foster home or adopted by a loving family. The Sallie House is a safe haven that these children temporarily call home.
